

Middlesex Township Board of Supervisors
Minutes of the Work Session Meeting
January 2, 2007

The Work Session Meeting of the Middlesex Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:22 p.m. Present were Chairman Alonzo Van Atta, Vice Chairman Mark Vincent, Supervisor Dave McMaster, Manager Scot Fodi, and Secretary Linda Young.

Marj Vincent presented the Parks and Recreation Committee Monthly Report.

Chairman Van Atta stated that the school bus patrol has been very effective and will continue for the remainder of the school year.

Chairman Van Atta reported that there will be no parking on the streets during snow events. The new garage doors are almost complete, and then the heaters will be installed.

Rosemary Brown, Lindo Lane, asked for more information regarding the building report. Manager Fodi gave an overview of the report.

On a motion of the Board of Supervisors the proposed amendment to the Uniform Pension Plan definition of Normal Retirement Date was tabled. Vice Chairman Vincent gave a brief review of the proposed amendment.

On a motion of McMaster and Vincent the Board of Supervisors approved Resolution #3 of 2007 entering into an Agreement with Scot E. Fodi for the position of Township Manager/Secretary. Motion carried unanimously.
