

Middlesex Township Board of Supervisors Minutes of the Spring Road Tour Meeting March 11, 2008

The Regular Meeting of the Middlesex Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 9:05 a.m. Present were Chairman Alonzo Van Atta, Vice Chairman Mark Vincent, Supervisor Mike Spreng, Scott Swansinger (HRG), John Rusnak (HRG), and Manager Scot Fodi. No one from the public was present.

Mr. Fodi reviewed the driving agenda for those in attendance and reminded all there that we would return to the building at the end of the tour to review and discuss the observed areas and develop a plan of action for the Road Department and awarded contractors to follow once winter season is over.

At 9:15 am, all meeting attendees tour the Township and specifically viewed or inspected the following roads or infrastructure issues in order to prepare the 2008 Road Resurfacing / Capital Improvement Program:

- North Drive culvert crossing and resurfacing
- Truver Road/Overbrook Road stormwater management/drainage improvements
- Overbrook Road shoulder repair and surface improvements
- Browns Hill Road, between Leslie Road and Overbrook Road
- Browns Hill Road shoulder slide area
- Old Route 8 South, Parks Road, State Road resurfacing
- Harbison Road resurfacing
- McFann Road / Hickory Lane stormwater management/drainage improvements
- Old Route 8 North wall collapse south of Holy Sepulcher Church parking lot

The Board returned to the municipal building after the tour to review the observed areas, discussed their findings in detail and developed the agenda for improvements for the rest of the calendar year.

On a motion by Vincent, seconded by Spreng the Board of Supervisors approved the purchase of an unmarked police vehicle not to exceed \$25,000.00. Motion carried unanimously.

On a motion by Vincent, seconded by Spreng the Board of Supervisors authorized Mr. Fodi to advertise the seal coat bid, if necessary. Motion carried unanimously.

On a motion by Vincent, seconded by Spreng the Board of Supervisors adjourned at 1:35 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
