

Middlesex Township Board of Supervisors
Minutes of the Regular Meeting
May 19, 2010

The Regular Meeting of the Middlesex Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 6:30 p.m. Present were Chairman Mark Vincent, Vice Chairman Mike Spreng, Supervisor Donald Marshall, Solicitor Michael Hnath, and Secretary Linda Young. Manager Scot Fodi was absent.

The Board of Supervisors met in Executive Session on April 28, 2010 from 3:15 p.m. to 4:55 p.m. with the Collective Bargaining Unit for the Middlesex Township Police Department Wage and Policy Unit and discussed the existing Collective Bargaining Agreement.

A. Dale Pinkerton, Butler County Commissioner, commented that he is making his rounds to all the Borough and Township meetings.

On a motion of Spreng, seconded by Marshall the Board of Supervisors approved the Minutes of the Regular Meeting of April 21, 2010. Motion carried unanimously.

Supervisors Spreng stated that he spoke with the VFC about the snow removal bills for this past winter and that he would like to talk to them about the road department plowing this winter.

On a motion of Spreng, seconded by Marshall the Board of Supervisors approved the Minutes of the Special Meeting of May 5, 2010. Motion carried unanimously.

On a motion of Spreng, seconded by Marshall the Board of Supervisors approved Warrant List #05-01-2010. Motion carried unanimously.

Chairman Vincent presented an overview of the COG Meeting of April 8, 2010 and also commented that the grant for the LED lights is on hold.

Vice Chairman Spreng commented that Shields will begin the 2010 Road Resurfacing Program on 5/20/2010 starting at Park Road/Old Route 8 South.

On a motion of Spreng, seconded by Marshall the Board of Supervisors adjourned at 6:48 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
