

Middlesex Township Board of Supervisors
Minutes of the Work Session Meeting
May 2, 2007

The Work Session Meeting of the Middlesex Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:00 p.m. Present were Chairman Alonzo Van Atta, Vice Chairman Mark Vincent, Supervisor Dave McMaster, Manager Scot Fodi, and Secretary Linda Young.

Mrs. Peggy Abersold introduced herself as a candidate for Judge for the Court of Common Pleas.

Eric Urbanowicz, Overbrook Road, asked why there was not going to be any more Work Session meetings. Chairman Van Atta stated that the Work Sessions are no longer needed or necessary.

On a motion of Vincent and McMaster the Board of Supervisors opened the Public Hearing for Ordinance #111 – Amending Chapter 65 at 7:10 p.m. and closed the Public Hearing at 7:15 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.

On a motion of Vincent and McMaster the Board of Supervisors enacted Township Ordinance #111 – Amending Chapter 65, Construction Codes, Uniform, of the Township Code, modifying the application of the UCC International Plumbing Code as it pertains to Public Utility Connections. Motion carried unanimously.

Route 228 Improvement Project Announcement – Public Hearing on June 7, 2007 at 6:00 p.m. at the Mars Area High School.

Bonnie Ciafre, Truver Road, commented that Middlesex Township should have been pursuing grant money for the resident's years ago. The residents have to pay for tap-ins, lateral lines, and a monthly fee and if they do not pay, their property will have a lien put against it. The residents of Middlesex Township were let down.

On a motion of Vincent and Van Atta the Board of Supervisors approved Minutes of the Regular Meeting of March 21, 2007 and the Minutes of the Work Session of April 4, 2007. Supervisor McMaster was not present at those meetings. Motion carried.

On a motion of Vincent and McMaster the Board of Supervisors approved Contract 07-03; Sale of 1995 Chevrolet Caprice to James Zedak for \$552.99. Motion carried unanimously.

On a motion of Vincent and McMaster the Board of Supervisors approved Contract 07-04; Sale of 1999 Ford Crown Victoria to Rogers Auto Sales for \$876.00. Motion carried unanimously.

On a motion of Vincent and McMaster the Board of Supervisors approved Contract 07-05; Sale of 2003 Ford Crown Victoria to Rogers Auto Sales for \$1,630.00. Motion carried unanimously.

On a motion of Vincent and McMaster the Board of Supervisors authorized the Township Manager to forward a response letter to John J. Bell of the Pennsylvania Farm Bureau. Motion carried unanimously.

Eric Urbanowicz, Overbrook Road, asked Chairman Van Atta if the only thing discussed in Executive Sessions is personnel issues. Chairman Van Atta stated that he has already answered that question several times before. Mr. Urbanowicz asked for an apology from Vice Chairman Vincent for swearing at him at a previous meeting. Vice Chairman Vincent had no comment.

On a motion of Vincent and McMaster the Board of Supervisors approved to discontinue the Work Sessions as of May 2, 2007. Motion carried unanimously.

On a motion of Vincent and McMaster the Board of Supervisors adjourned at 7:35 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
