

Middlesex Township Board of Supervisors
Minutes of the Regular Meeting
June 16, 2010

The Regular Meeting of the Middlesex Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 6:30 p.m. Present were Chairman Mark Vincent, Vice Chairman Mike Spreng, Supervisor Donald Marshall, Solicitor Michael Hnath, Manager Scot Fodi, and Secretary Linda Young.

The Board of Supervisors met in Executive Session on June 4, 2010 from 1:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. to discuss the proposed Collective Bargaining Agreement with the Middlesex Township Police Department Wage and Policy Unit.

Lonnie Van Atta said that he was happy that the Penn-Middlesex Enhanced Mutual Aid Agreement was moving forward.

Doug Roth, Penn Township Board of Supervisor, commended the Penn and Middlesex Police Departments for putting the agreement together.

Denny Crawford, Penn Township Police Officer, stated that the two police departments have a very good working relationship.

Andy Lutzic, Twinbrook Road, commented that it would be a good idea for the two police departments to ride around the other Township to get familiar with the roads and to have a group picture of the officers in the Butler Eagle so that residents can identify the officers from the other Township.

On a motion of Spreng, seconded by Marshall the Board of Supervisors approved the Penn-Middlesex Enhanced Mutual Aid Agreement for a one year term. Motion carried unanimously.

On a motion of Spreng, seconded by Marshall the Board of Supervisors approved the Regular Meeting Minutes of May 19, 2010. Motion carried unanimously.

On a motion of Spreng, seconded by Marshall the Board of Supervisors approved Warrant List #06-01-2010. Motion carried unanimously.

Manager Fodi commented on some correspondence received. A resident from Dwellington Drive requested putting up "ONE WAY" signs where Dwellington Drive separates into two single lanes or signs to bear right or left of the island.

Chairman Vincent stated that Health Care Plans were the topic of discussion at the COG meeting on June 10, 2010.

On a motion of Spreng, and seconded by Marshall the Board of Supervisors appointed Marj Vincent, Overbrook Road, to the Parks and Recreation Committee. Chairman Vincent abstained. Motion carried.

Manager Fodi stated that the 2010 Middlesex Township Directory and Map are being mailed out to all residents and businesses.

On a motion of Spreng, seconded by Marshall the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 10 of 2010 granting Preliminary and Final Approval to the Hawkins Family Farm, LLC Subdivision Plan, located in the AG-A Zoning District. Motion carried unanimously.

Jane Peterson, Harbison Road, said at the intersection of Harbison Road and Route 228, the trees on the left are blocking the view to pull out onto Route 228. Vice Chairman Spreng said that he would have the tree company that is cutting the tree down on Park Road also trim those trees back.

Ellen Flemma, Harbison Road, thanked that Board for the continued progress of fixing the roads.

Sid Smith, Middlesex Township Volunteer Fire Company, commented that the VFC is contracting out address # plates from Ibis Tek at a cost of \$6.91, but will be selling them to the residents for \$10.00. The VFC will be mailing out the Ordinance along with an order form for the address plates. They are blue to match the new Middlesex Township street signs. The residents may also purchase a street sign elsewhere or make their own, in compliance with the Ordinance. The Ordinance will be enforced.

On a motion of Spreng, seconded by Marshall the Board of Supervisors adjourned to executive session to discuss police personnel at 7:07 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
